

SCIF HUMANITARIAN SERVICES 2019 VETERAN'S BREAKFAST SWEEPSTAKES OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR DONATION NECESSARY TO ENTER. A PURCHASE OR DONATION WILL NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

Eligibility. Open only to legal residents of the 50 United States, District of Columbia or Canada who are age 18 or older at time of entry. Employees of Safari Club International ("SCI") and Safari Club International Foundation ("SCIF" or "Sponsor") and members of their immediate family or household are not eligible. Void in Quebec, Canada and where prohibited, taxed, or restricted. This Sweepstakes is conducted in the United States and is governed by applicable US law.

How to Enter. This Sweepstakes begins on or about 7:00 a.m. Pacific Time (PT), January 11, 2019, during the Veteran's Breakfast Program, held at the Reno-Sparks Convention Center, Reno, NV., and ends approximately 9:00 a.m. Pacific Time (PT) on January 11, 2019 ("Sweepstakes Period"). During the Sweepstakes Period, make a suggested donation to a SCIF representative during the Veteran's Breakfast of \$25.00(US) and receive one entry into the drawing, or make a suggested donation of \$100.00(US) to receive five entries into the drawing, or make a suggested donation of \$250.00(US) to receive fifteen entries into the drawing, or during the Sweepstakes Period, obtain one (1) free entry by completing a 3 x 5 card or piece of paper with hand printed name, address, age and daytime phone number, and drop it in the official SCIF Humanitarian Services 2019 Veteran's Breakfast Sweepstakes entry box located in the North Hall Breezeway of the Reno-Sparks Convention Center.

There are a maximum of 2000 entry tickets in this Sweepstakes. Limit 15 entries per person, regardless of method of entry. Any use of robotic, repetitive, automatic, programmed or similar entry methods or agents (including, but not limited to sweepstakes entry services) are prohibited and will void all entries by that entrant. All entries, regardless of method, must be received by SCIF by the deadlines set forth above. Entrant assumes risk of loss, damage, destruction, delay and misdirection of entries, and is solely responsible for postage due, illegible or incomplete entries. Drawing. 3 winners will be selected in a random drawing on January 11, 2019 at the end of the Veteran's Breakfast Program as directed by the Master of Ceremonies, from all eligible entries received. You do not need to be present to win. The drawing will be conducted by an SCIF representative, whose decisions are final and binding in all respects. If a Canadian resident is selected in the drawing, he/she must correctly answer a skill-testing question in order to claim the prize. The question will be administered upon notification to the Canadian resident that he/she was selected. To receive the prize, the question must be correctly answered without assistance of any kind, within a specified time limit.
