Education Sables Volunteers

Education Sables members are encouraged to serve on committees that help to set the direction of Education Sables as a membership organization and the direction of SCIF Education programs. This is an opportunity to network with Education Sables volunteers and to play a role in educating future generations regarding conservation and the positive role of hunting. Our goal is to

develop future leaders and advocates who will promote our outdoor heritage.

Hands On Wildlife Conservation Learning Kit

Hands On Wildlife (HOW) Kit is a k-12 instructional tool designed by Education Sables to provide hands-on learning about wildlife. The core curriculum is the North American Model of Wildlife Management. Filled with



pelts, casts of tracks, models of scat and skulls, the Kit provides many items that sparks learning excitement. Teachers and others now have the resources to introduce wildlife habitat and management and human/wildlife interactions to young people.

For many, the **HOW Kit** provides the student's first contact with a wild animal. Hands On Wildlife Kit helps adults and young people in our increasingly urban environment re-establish a link to the natural world. The Kit can be purchased from Education Sables and they have a limited number of Kits to gift to teachers or schools.



Education Sables Hunting Heritage Scholarships

Five endowed scholarships provide merit-base financial assistance for college juniors and seniors studying wildlife science at the following universities:

- **Joe Leta Scholarship** – Unity College in Maine
- **SCIF Education Sables Hunting Heritage Scholarship** – Texas A & M University – Kingsville

- **Susan and John Monson Scholarship** – University of Montana - Missoula

SCIF Foundation Scholarships

SCIF offers two types of college scholarships. A four-year scholarship is for outstanding freshman students who are recommended through Safari Club International Chapters. Preference is given, but not limited to, applicants seeking a degree in or a related field of conservation.

An upper level scholarship is for college students in their junior or senior year of academic standing. Applicants must be committed to sustainable use of natural resources and the role of hunting.

American Wilderness Leadership School

AWLS offers a college level course - "Conservation for Educators" with a focus on the North American Model of Wildlife Management.

Additional program components include shooting sports, Archery in the Schools training, curriculum and materials to incorporate in school programs, and stream ecology. Field trips to the Pinedale gas fields and Teton

Youth Programs

SCIF Foundation Education Sables has four grant programs.

- **Chapter Youth Program Grants** support youth programs that are sustained for at least 3 years and create partnerships with like-minded organizations. The goal is to increase awareness of and engage youth in conservation and shooting sports activities and to increase the number of youth participating in SCI and SCIF sponsored activities.
- **Education Matching Grants** provides support to SCI Chapters and Chapter Education Sables Committees for education programs that introduce adults to conservation and shooting sports activities.
- **Conservation Education grants** are available to support conservation programs in North America and internationally. These are awarded through a competitive application process.
- **Education Partnership Grants** support the National Archery in the Schools Program, the 4-H National Shooting Sports Ambassadors, the International Hunter Education Association Heritage Hunt, and Outdoor Writers of American Norm Strung Youth Writing Contest.

The Salvation Army Outdoors

Education Sables, SCI Chapters and The Salvation Army Outdoors, as partners, developed youth programs in the Central Territory where nearly 150,000 youth each year can learn about wildlife management, hunting, gain skills in archery and in basic rifle and participate in mentored hunts. TSAO will be expanded into more Salvation Army Territories where even more youth can learn and enjoy these outdoor activities.
